MONDAY, MARCH 21, 2022

Following lunch at the Breakers' Flagler's Steakhouse, have free time to explore the Breakers' grounds and gift shops. Dine together at a popular West Palm Beach restaurant.

Morikami & The Mounts Botanical Garden

This evening, savor a remarkable farewell dinner in West Palm Beach.

FRIDAY, MARCH 25, 2022

The Norton & Farewell

Walk to the Norton Museum of Art for a guided tour of collection highlights followed by lunch in the museum's café. Join a group transfer to the airport for flights home.
